## Commonwealth Utilities Corporation Schedule R Residential Service

Applicable to single phase residential lighting, heating, cooking, air conditioning and power in a single family dwelling unit metered and billed separately by the CUC. This schedule does not apply where residence and business are combined. Where premises are used for both residential and commercial purposes, the service shall be billed as commercial service. If the area of residential use and commercial use is clearly defined, then the residential area may be served under the residential rate if a separate meter is installed.

Monthly rate:

Non-fuel energy charge

1 - 350	kWh per month	\$0.0210 per kWh
351-1,200	kWh per month	\$0.0970 per kWh
1,201 and above	kWh per month	\$0.1580 per kWh

Customer charge \$7.00 per month

Levelized Energy Adjustment Clause:

The Levelized Energy Adjustment Clause, as specified in Schedule XX, will be added to each bill for service.

Public Law 16-7 Credit:

Public Law 16-7 mandates that CUC shall provide residential electric ratepayers with a \$3.4 million refund. The Public Law 16-7 Credit was established by the Commonwealth Public Utilities Commission on February 5, 2014. The effective date of the Credit is March 1, 2014.

All kWh per month (\$0.0230) per kWh

Infrastructure Surcharge:

An Infrastructure Surcharge was established by the Commonwealth Public Utilities Commission on February 5, 2014. The purpose of the surcharge is to fund CUC's remaining obligations under its June 4, 2012, agreement with Pacific Marine and Industrial Corporation. The surcharge applies to all customer classes and will expire on January 1, 2015.

All kWh per month \$0.021 per kWh

Service supplied under this rate shall be subject to the regulations set forth in NMIAC Volume 1 Title 50.

Riders:

Charges in addition to the above are applicable under certain conditions more specifically set forth and incorporated herein.
